

# Nanded on the Air Map of India

**NANDED:** While the problem of transport in the Marathwada region of Maharashtra is still in its infancy, the Gurta Gaddi celebrations have ensured that Nanded gets a full-fledged airport, which has been connected on the domestic sector to Mumbai, with plans to connect it with Hyderabad, Delhi and Amritsar.

Presently there are three flights in a week (Monday, Wednesday and Friday) from Mumbai to Nanded by Kingfisher Airlines. This service will also be made daily from 30<sup>th</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> November.

According to the announcement of the Civil Aviation Minister, there will be Amritsar-Delhi-Nanded flight from 29<sup>th</sup> October to 4<sup>th</sup> November and in all likelihood this flight service will be continued.

The airport is likely to be renamed as Guru Gobind Singh Airport.

## Maharashtra: Chetna Yatra reaches Nanded

**Aurangabad:** The Chetna Yatra which began from Mumbai on Sunday, reached Nanded today after an overnight stay in Aurangabad.

The yatra carrying is Palkhi Sahib specially made from gold for Guru-ta-Gaddi tercentenary festival.

Local Sikh community members gave it a warm welcome in the Aurangabad by raising slogans like "'300 Saal Guru De Naal, Raj Karega Khalsa.' The Guru-ta-Gaddi tercentenary festival being held in Nanded.

The palanquin reached Aurangabad in the form of Guru Grant Sahib Chetna Yatra via Mumbai, Pune, Ahmednagar, Nasik, Manmad and Yeola and accompanied by a caravan of around 100 vehicles.

Baba Jagtarsinha Tarantaranwale, Sardar Kulwant Singh and Sardar Ajit Singh are accompanying with the Palkhi which was taken to Shri Gurusinghsabha Gurudwara where various programmes were held in its honour.

The arrangement for caravan was made at Khalsa ground and Shri Guru Tegbahadur Langar Sahib Gurudwara.

After an overnight's stay, the yatra left Aurangabad this morning and reached Nanded.
